Prior to installing a manufactured home, a permit is required from the County Auditor (740-385-2127) and the Industrial Compliance Section of the Ohio Department of Commerce (800-523-3581).

I further agree to obtain a Building Placement Permit prior to home placement/construction. I agree to install, operate, and maintain the sewage treatment system (STS) in accordance with all local and state codes. I understand that wet or frozen conditions may delay system installation. I agree to contact the Health Department for final inspection of the STS at least 1 business day prior to backfilling and will not occupy the property until the system is approved. The Hocking County Health Department assumes no responsibility for the efficient functioning of any sewage or water system.

Building Placement Permit (BPP):

Prior to placing or building a home whether for new construction or when replacing a home, a Building Placement Permit is required. Please contact this office to schedule an appointment for a sanitarian to meet at the site to inspect the condition of the existing sewage treatment system and private water system unless connected to a public water system.

Existing Sewage Treatment Systems (STS):

An existing STS may be used if it meets the following requirements:

- The system is not creating a public health nuisance.
- All components are operating correctly as designed and are in good condition.
- Septic tanks and aerators must have risers with accessible lids at or above grade.
- Discharging aerators must have a motor that is designed for that unit (a Jet aerator must have a Jet motor and a Norweco aerator must have a Norweco motor).

Septic tanks that are buried with no riser access must be located and uncovered prior to inspection. A dye test may be conducted. Per Section 3701-29 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), cesspools, drywells, and metal tanks cannot be used and must be replaced with a system that meets the requirements of OAC 3701-29. This may entail a site/soil evaluation and permits from this office for the installation of a new STS.

Existing Private Water Systems (PWS):

An existing PWS such as a well, spring, cistern, or water storage tank may be used if it was permitted and approved and no code violations are evident such as a missing well cap. Hand dug wells do not meet the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-28 and cannot be used. Cisterns and springs must have continuous disinfection.

In order to appove an unapproved well, the following must take place:

- Contact a Licensed PWS contractor to conduct a downhole camera survey and submit a well log.
- Once the well log is approved, obtain a PWS alteration/conversion permit. The well and all components including the pressure tank must meet the requirements of OAC 3701-28
- Obtain a safe water sample.
