- ☐ Advocating for your facility's and clients' needs

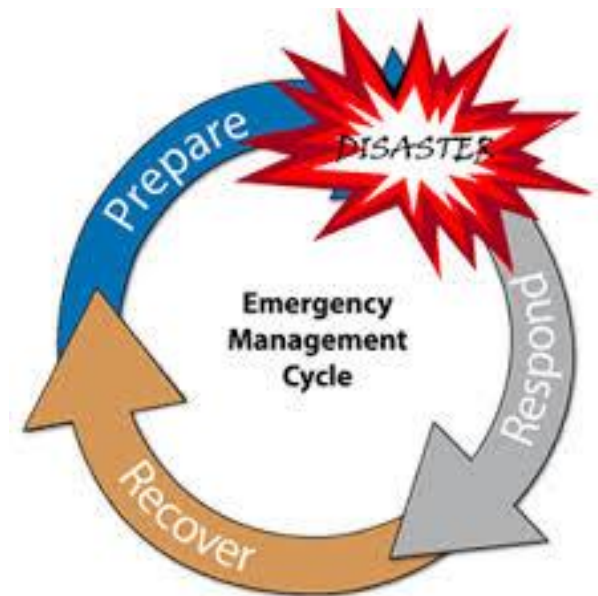
Emergency Operations Planning
