

The Hocking County Health Department will start flu clinics on Monday, September 24th at the Health Department. Flu shots will be available between 8am and 4pm, Monday-Friday, with a few late clinics going till 6:30pm (see below for dates). Clinics will be walk-in clinics, with no appointment necessary.
