

Hepatitis C testing is done by appointment only.

Testing is free of charge.

In order to receive Hepatitis C testing you must have one of the following risk factors:

- 1. History of injection drug use**
- 2. History of blood transfusion/organ transplant before July 1992**
- 3. History of occupational exposure to blood (ex. needle stick or blood splash)**
- 4. History of sex with a known HCV positive partner**
- 5. History of non-professional tattoo**
- 6. History of sharing straws when snorting drugs**
- 7. History of non-occupational exposure to blood (ex. fights, first aid to an injured person, etc.)**
- 8. HIV positive**

The test is a finger stick and results are normally received from the lab 3 weeks after the test.
