

# Registration Requirements

In accordance with Logan-Hocking County Health District Plumbing Regulation #5, the following contractors must maintain a current registration with the Hocking County Health Department in order to conduct plumbing covered by Regulation 5 within Logan City and Hocking County:

**Plumbing Contractors** – must provide current State of Ohio Contractor’s License, \$20,000 bond and proof of general liability insurance.

**Journeyman Plumbers** – pass the Journeyman’s test and be employed by a contractor registered with Hocking County Health Department.

**Apprentice Plumbers** – employed by a contractor registered with Hocking County Health Department.

**Backflow Technicians** – must have current state of Ohio Backflow Tester Certification and current calibration of test equipment.

**Water Conditioner Installers** - \$ 20,000.00 bond and proof of general liability insurance.

All registrations expire on December 31 and must be renewed prior to expiration. There is a penalty fee for plumbing without registration and or plumbing without a permit.

**Bonds must state what they are for (i.e. plumbing contractor or water conditioner installer), name the Hocking County Health Department as the obligee and expire on December 31.**

Homeowners do not need to register in order to install or alter plumbing in their home if ***it is their primary residence***. However, proper permits are required prior to commencing work.
