

The Hocking County Health Department is pleased to announce that in addition to our current Hepatitis C and HIV testing, we are adding STD testing for Chlamydia and Gonorrhea to qualified residents. The Ohio Department of Health provides the test kits and treatment to us free of charge. In order for the client to be tested for STD's, they must meet one of the following criteria:

- Males or females, age 29 or younger
- Males or females, regardless of age, who are contacts to patients who have tested positive for Chlamydia or Gonorrhea
- Males or females, regardless of age, who exhibit signs or symptoms of an STD
- Males or females, regardless of age, who need to be rescreened following an initial positive test (recommendation is three months after treatment)
